### **General Information**

This lovely church with its Norman Tower stands on a hilltop, half a mile from the village itself. The nave and aisle are largely Perpendicular in character whilst the chancel dates from the 14<sup>th</sup> century and is Decorated in style. The church contains many attractive features including : its arch braced roof, the rood screen and most importantly its heptagonal wineglass pulpit with six painted panels.

Only the East window contains stained glass comprising two beautiful art deco figures depicting St Margaret of Antioch & St Margaret of Scotland.

### **East Window**

Very little is known about this very pretty Art Deco window which was installed c1920. It depicts St Margaret of Antioch, surrounded by daisies, and St Margaret of Scotland, reading a book.
