Village trail of Ketteringham Mulbarton Saxlingham Nethergate and Shelton

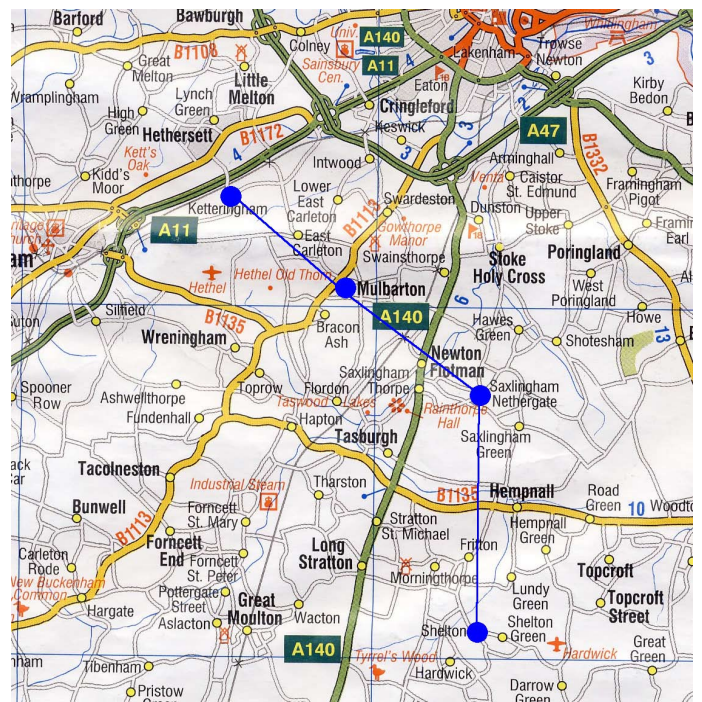
Summary

This tour concentrates on Medieval stained glass. It provides brilliant and interesting examples of the genre.

Highlights:

- Earliest Stained glass in a Norfolk church (Saxlingham Nethergate)
- Almost complete typical 15th century combination of tracery figures giving a unique insight into the craft at the time (Ketteringham)
- Some of the county's best examples of early 16th century glass painting (Shelton)
- Beautiful Adam & Eve figures (Mulbarton)
